

DISCIPLINE ANNOTATION:

ENGLISH

The goal of the English discipline is to teach students to communicate in a foreign language, develop all types of speech skills, master communication skills in a foreign language, expand vocabulary and develop skills in translation from a foreign language into a native language and vice versa.

Subject matter: large vocabulary and grammar of the language to carry out communication and get the necessary information.

After learning the discipline, students should

know:

the large vocabulary and grammar of the language to carry out communication and get the necessary information.

be able to:

read and fully understand texts;

perceive foreign speech;

freely use oral monologue and dialogic speech in everyday topics;

translate texts from the foreign language into the native one and vice versa;

draw up documents necessary for employment;

have skills in writing business correspondence;

have communication skills to talk to partners from other countries.

Key objectives of the course: to improve communication skills and foreign language skills when communicating at business and professional levels; to supplement the personal lexical base with terminology and idiomatic expressions used in business communication situations; to form students' modern ideas about business etiquette in Ukraine and foreign-speaking countries; to develop the ability to behave professionally in various life situations of business communication; learn how to write an individual business portfolio in a foreign language: autobiography, CV, statement, motivational letter, etc.; to improve oral and written translation skills using grammatical transformations in business texts; improve the skills of monologue and dialogic speech using the vocabulary of the course, learn language clichés and key expressions.
