ABSTRACT OF THE ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE

"MEDICAL SUBCULTURE"

DESCRIPTION OF THE DISCIPLINE

The subject "Medical Subculture" is taught for specialists of the second (master) level, the field of knowledge 22 "Health Care", specialty - 222 "Medicine", who are studying at the 4th year.

The subject is taught in the autumn semester of the 2020/2021 academic year.

GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE DISCIPLINE

An important condition for the development of modern Ukrainian society is the formation of a powerful educational potential of the nation, achieving the highest quality of student training. Successful development of their profession by future doctors requires in-depth knowledge of the features of professional and corporate ethics, norms of behavior and morality, worldviews and value orientations that exist in the modern medical space. Studying this discipline requires students to take a creative approach to solving educational problems and the ability to determine their own trajectory of the educational process, which will allow them to make the most effective use of academic hours.

THE ROLE AND PLACE OFDISCIPLINES AND IN THE SYSTEM OF TRAINING SPECIALISTS

"Medical subculture" is an educational discipline that studies the specifics of medical activity and features of medical cognition, the thinking style of a doctor, his personal culture, attributes, Customs and traditions. The very concept of "Health" today is perceived as a concept not only biomedical, but also socio-cultural. Value orientations play an increasingly important role in the medical research of a scientist and the activities of a practitioner. The professional group of medical workers is a significant original community, relatively closed, differs from other professional groups in a number of features, has its own ethics, norms of behavior and morals, ideas about the professionalism and personality of a professional, worldview ideas that are reflected in certain rituals, folklore, etc. the course is focused on helping students to facilitate the process of socialization in the modern professional medical environment of Ukraine and the world.

THE PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE DISCIPLINE

Goal: Toform in senior students the knowledge necessary for successful socialization in the community of professional doctors.

Objective: In accordance with the requirements of the standard, discipline should ensure that students acquire the following competencies:

General competencies:

- the ability to abstract thinking, analysis and synthesis, ability to learn and be modernly trained;
- the ability to apply knowledge in practical situations;
- nowledge and understanding of the subject area and understanding of professional activity;
- the ability to adapt and act in a new situation;
- the ability to make informed decisions; work in a team; interpersonal skills;
- the ability to communicate in the state language both orally and in writing;
- skills of using information and communication technologies;
- certainty and perseverance about the tasks and responsibilities taken;
- the ability to act socially responsibly and consciously;



• striving for environmental conservation;

Professional competences:

- survey skills;
- the ability to determine the principles and nature of disease treatment;
- the ability to maintain medical records;
- the ability to conduct epidemiological and medical and statistical studies of public health; processing of state, social, economic and medical information;
- the ability to analyze the activities of a doctor, unit, health care institution, carry out measures to ensure the quality and safety of medical care and increase the efficiency of the use of medical resources;
- the ability to carry out activities on the organization and integration of medical care to the population, and marketing of medical services.

The applicant of higher education during the period of study acquires communication skills, develops leadership skills, learns to take responsibility and work in critical conditions, solves pedagogical situations and conflicts, knows how to work in a team, manages his time, thinks logically and systematically, has creative approaches to solving the problem.

PREREQUISITE AND POSTREQUISITE DISCIPLINES

Prerequisite. The study of discipline involves preliminary assimilation of subjects that give basic ideas abouteducation: "History of Ukraine and Ukrainian culture", "Philosophy"; "Culturology", "Local History", "Medicine and Art Culture", "Ethics", "Religious Studies".

Postrequisite. "Medical subculture «substantively integrates with disciplines that provide further training of medical students: "Social medicine, health care organization", "Occupational diseases", "Psychiatry", "Medicine and politics", "Medical Kharkov in personalities", which students study in 5-6 courses, etc.

SCOPE OF ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE

90 hours, 3 credits. Practical classes are provided -30 hours, for independent work of students -60 hours, lecture classes are not provided. The material is structured into 4 topics.
