### INFORMATION ABOUT DISCIPLINE

Educational program of higher education, the second (master's) level, educational qualification, assigned - Master, field of knowledge - 22 Health care, specialty 222 "Medicine" was drawn up on the basis of the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education" and the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine 01.02.2017 № 53 "On Amendments to the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine 29.04.2015 No 266", in accordance with the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine 01.06.2016 № 600 "On approval and enactment of guidelines for the development of higher education standards".

By the nature of the logic of cognition, the following methods are used: analytical, synthetic, analytical-synthetic, inductive, deductive.
